



How can we begin to tackle the acute shortage of water that threatens our town's future? How can we make our public buildings sustainable and safe places especially for our school age children?

In 2018 Kitui Town Administration will be supporting three critical public services in Kwa Vonza – our primary and secondary school and dispensary.

Our approach is simple. Focusing on our crucial need for more water, we will demonstrate how catching and storing rain water that falls on the roofs of these buildings can make an important contribution to filling the gap in water supply.

The water stored in six large water tanks will be

used by staff and pupils and greatly reduce the amount of time and effort school children use to collect water. We will be promoting more healthy and hygienic places.

We are also committed to improving the use and safety of our public buildings after dark by providing lighting at all three facilities. The lights will be solar powered – addressing another of our limitations in Kwa Vonza: a very unreliable power supply.
