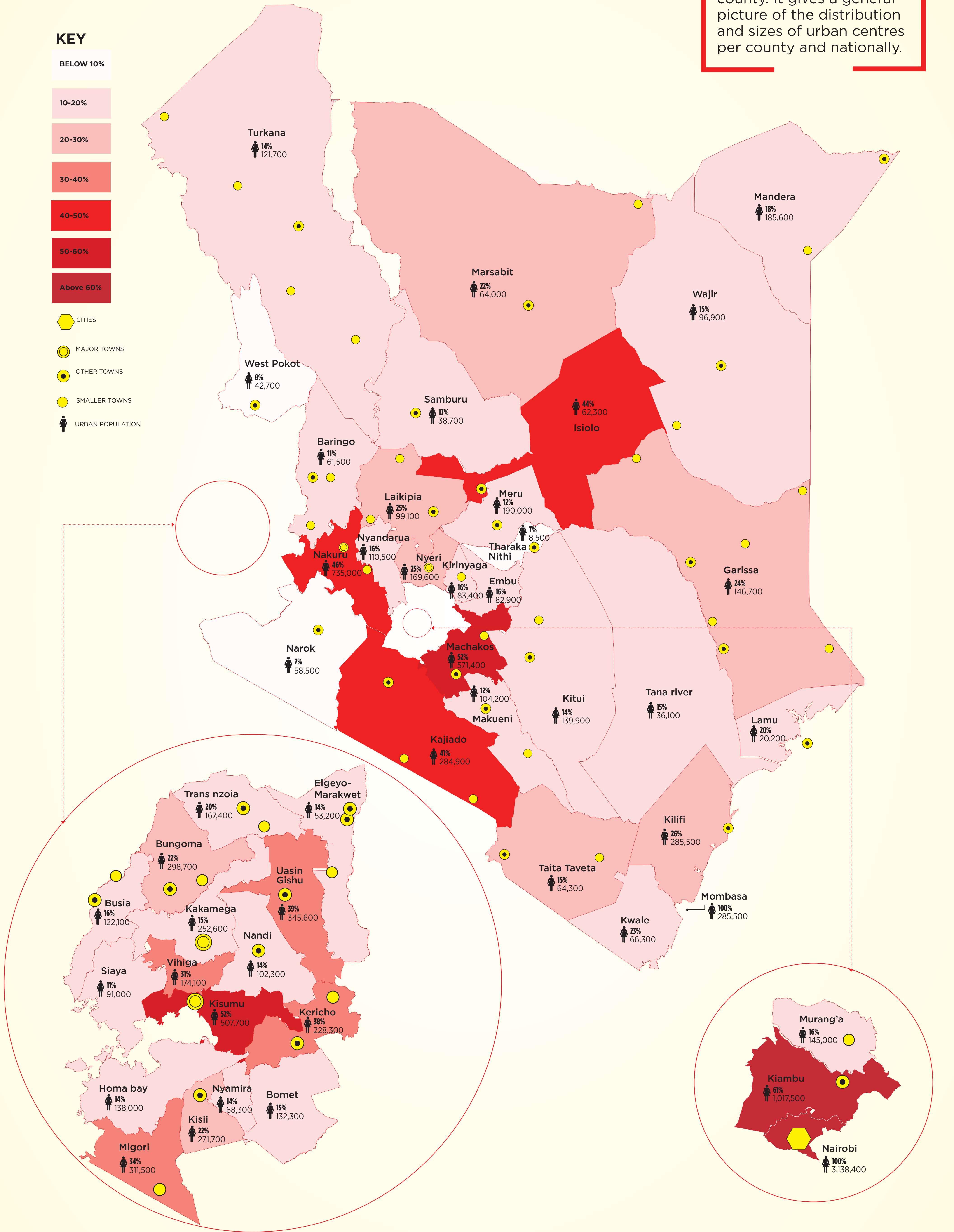


Urbanisation in Kenyan Counties

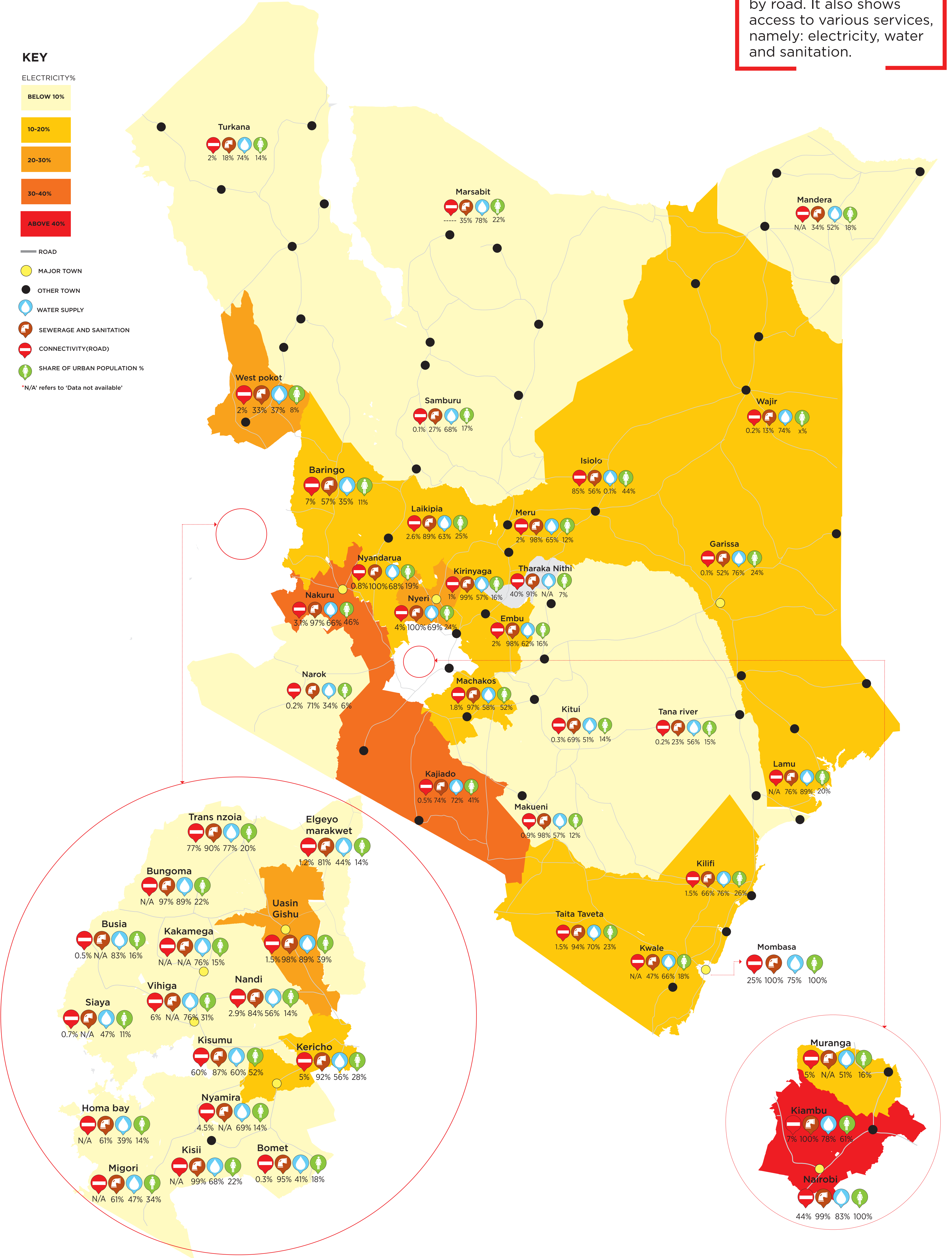

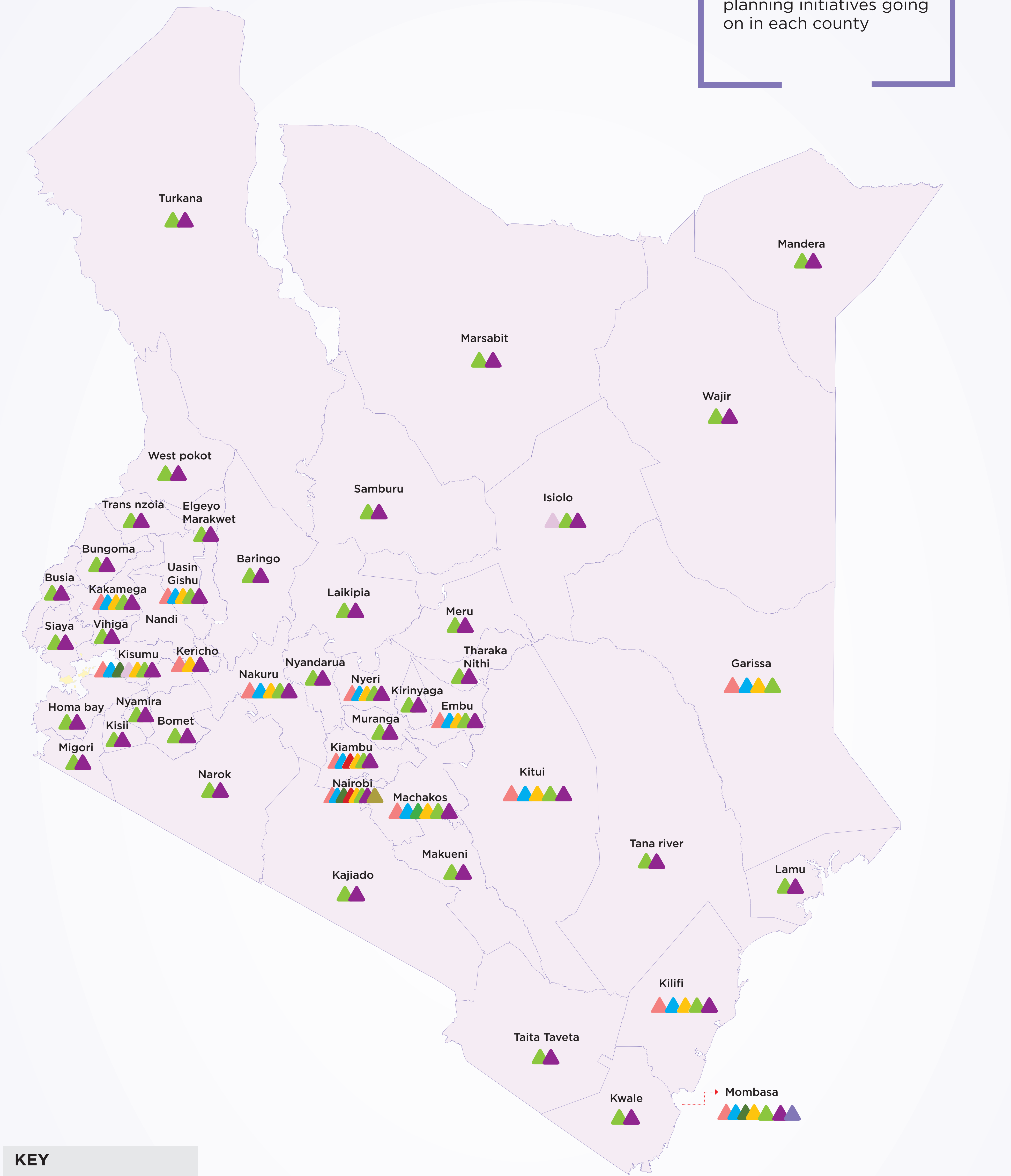

- County Integrated Development Plans (CIDPs)**

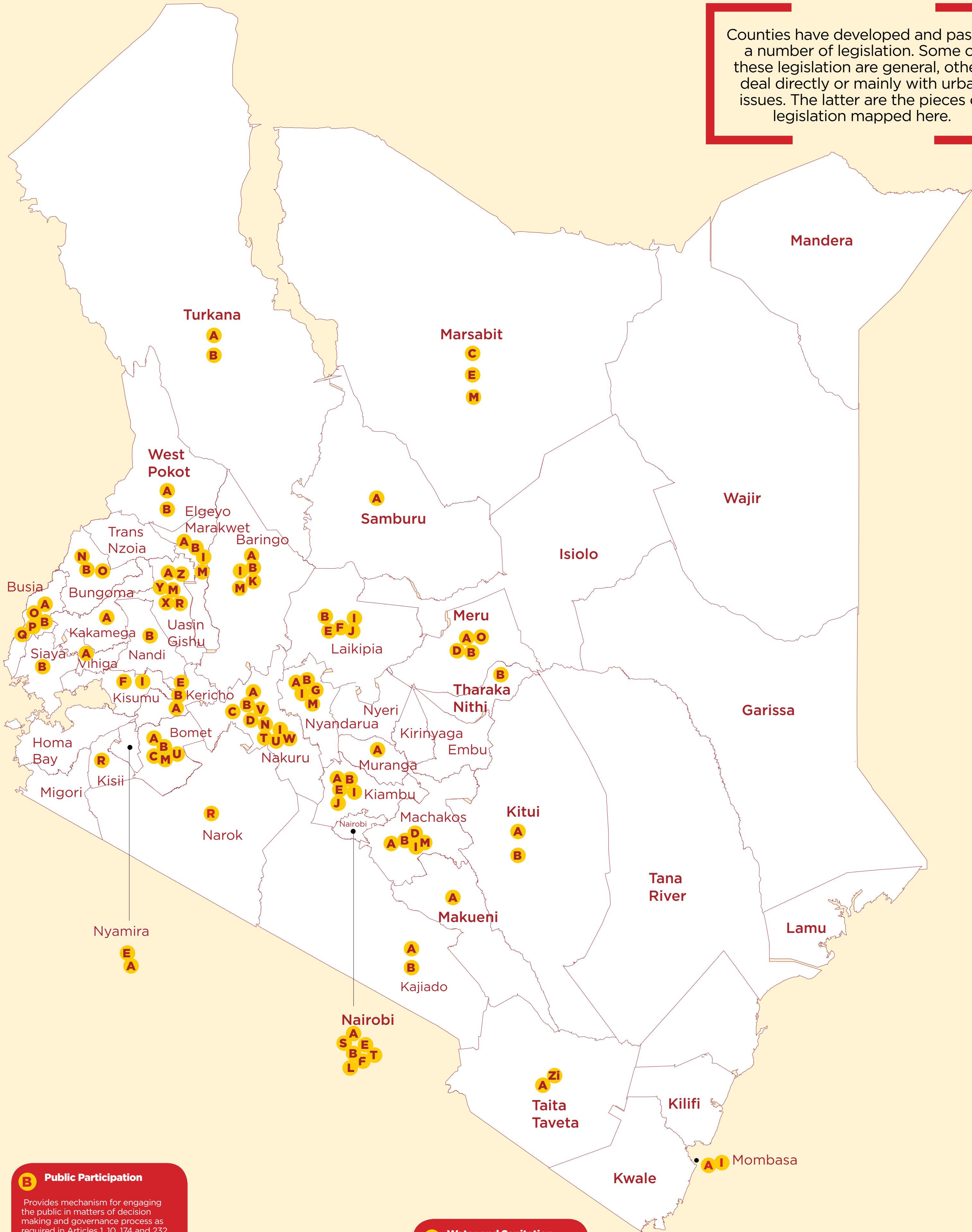
The County Government's Act, 2012 (CGA), 104 obligates a county to develop among other county plans, a County Integrated Development Plan (CIDP). This is a 5-year plan that shall inform the county's annual budget. it shall reflect the strategic mid-term priorities of the county governments

A platform that brings together over 900 Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), County Officials and Private sector actors to promote knowledge based dialogue on the evolving urban landscape in Kenya

Regulates the supply of electricity in the retail market; to set out the functions of persons engaged in the conveyance and supply of electricity and for connected purposes

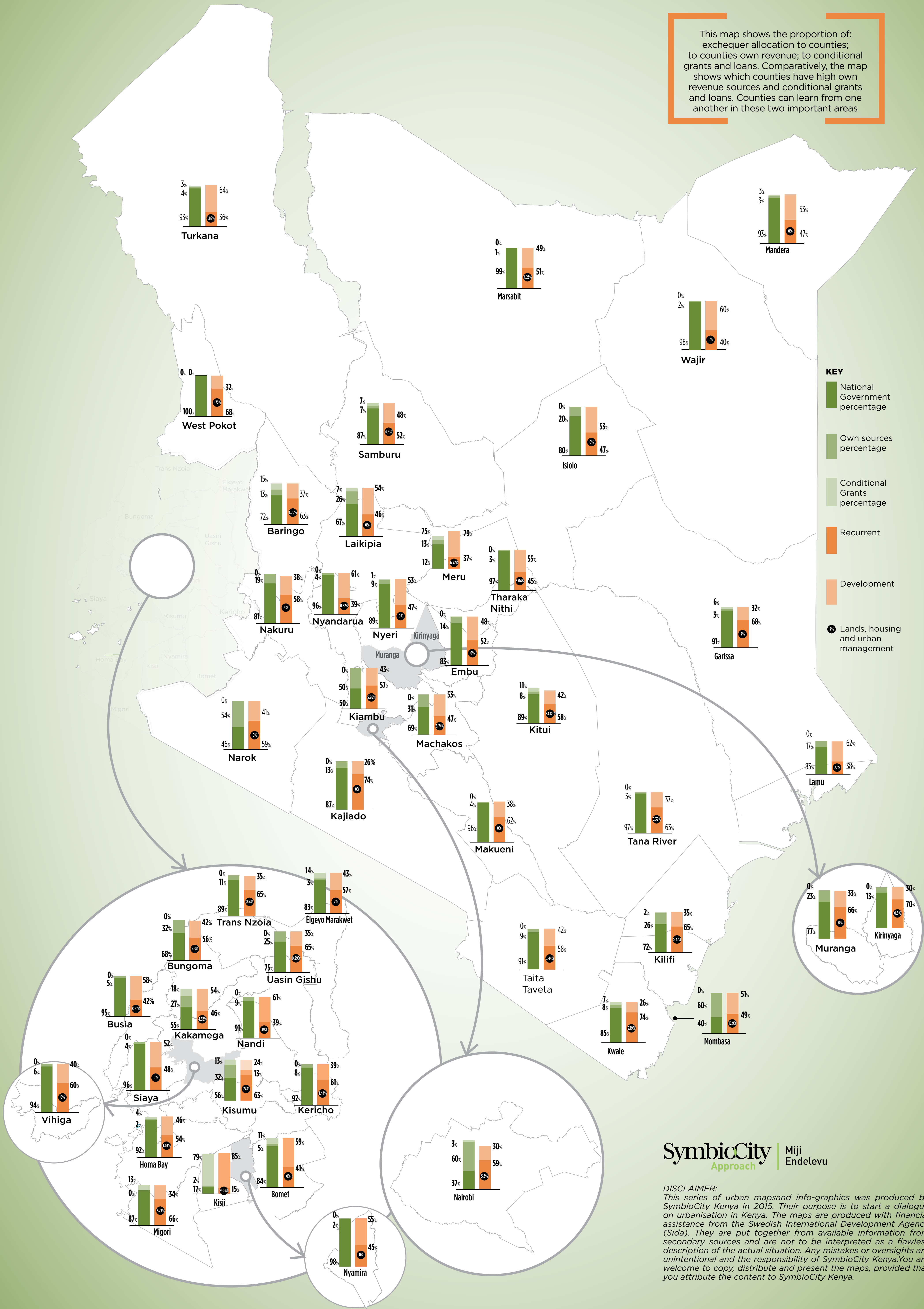

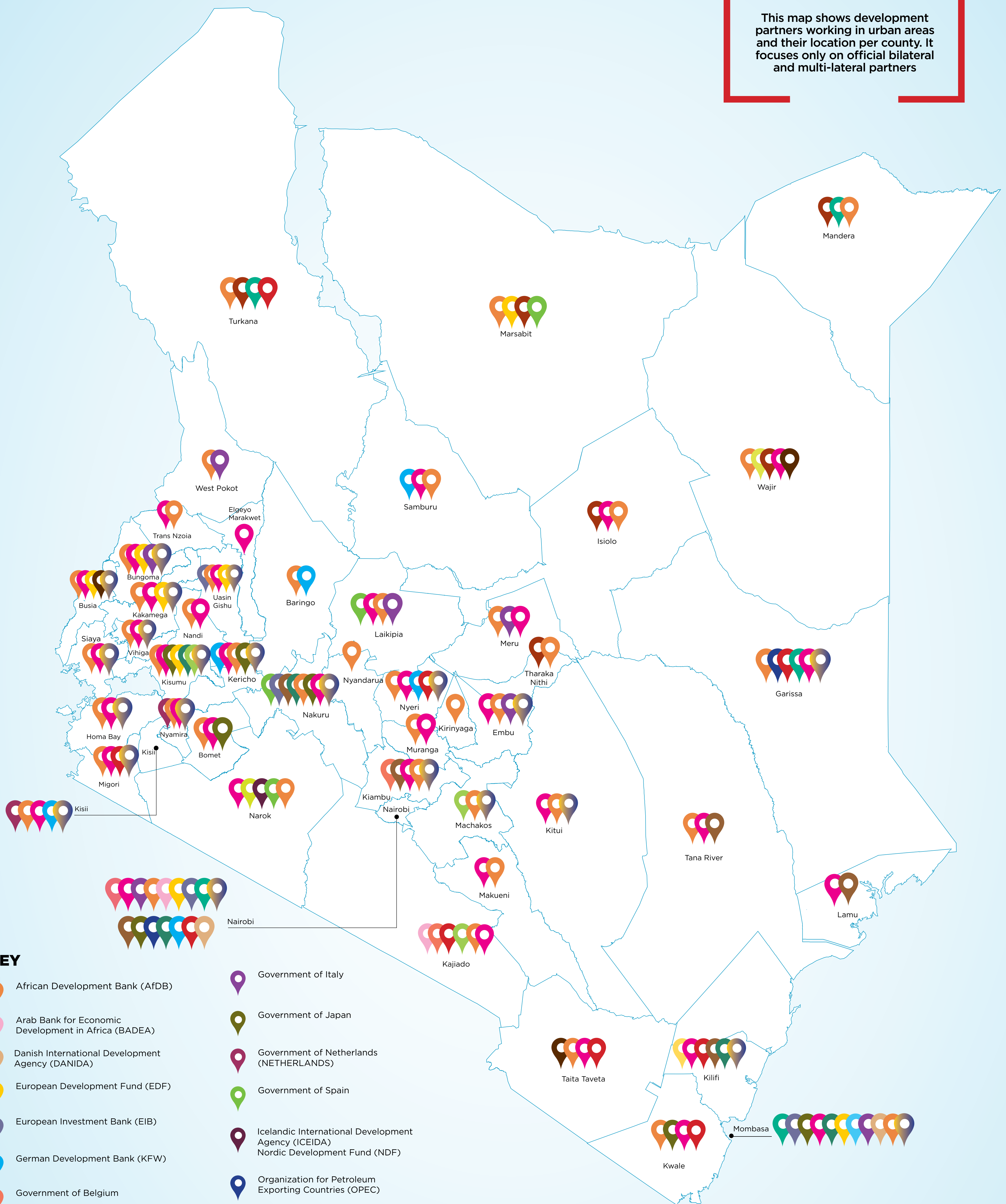

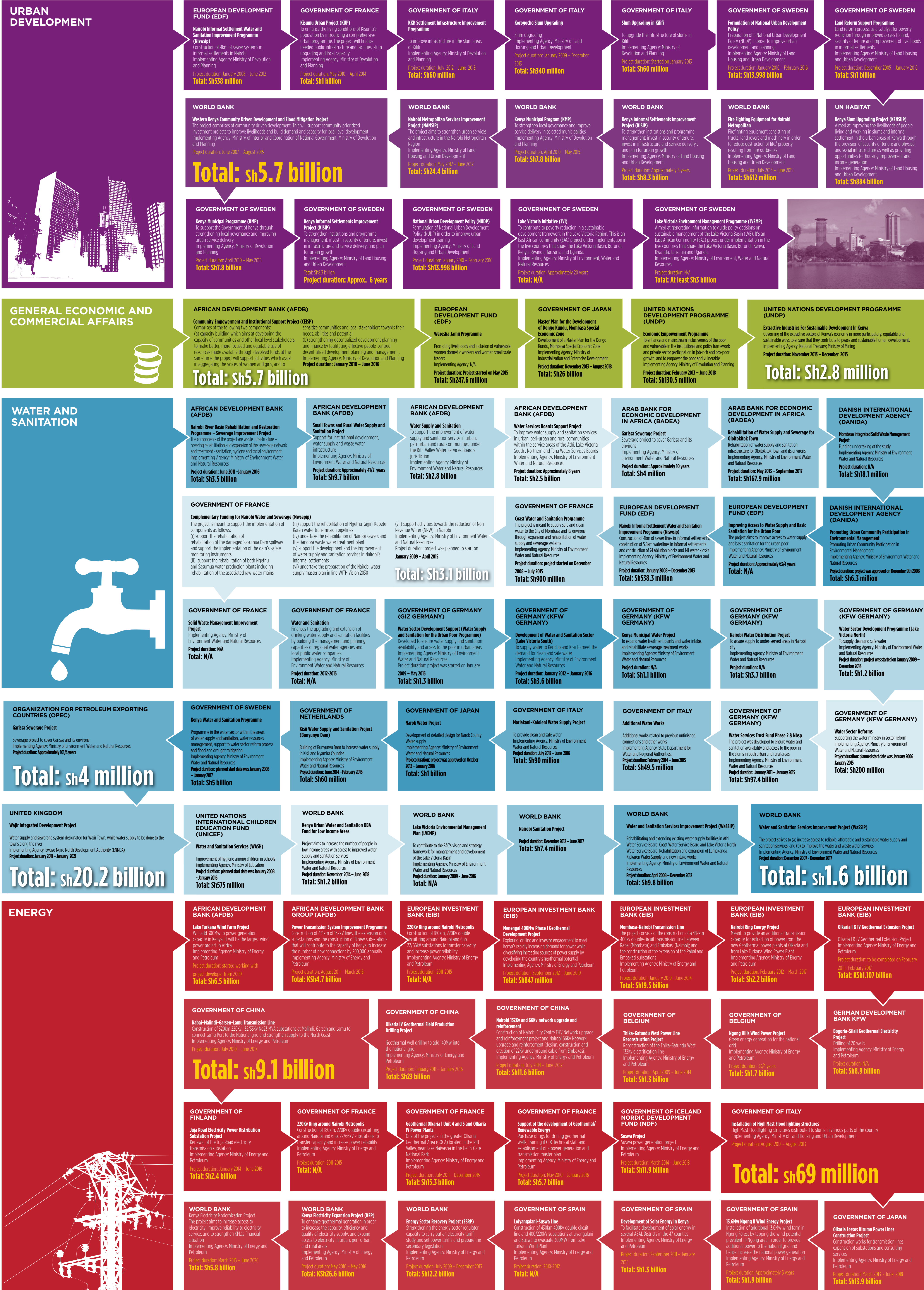

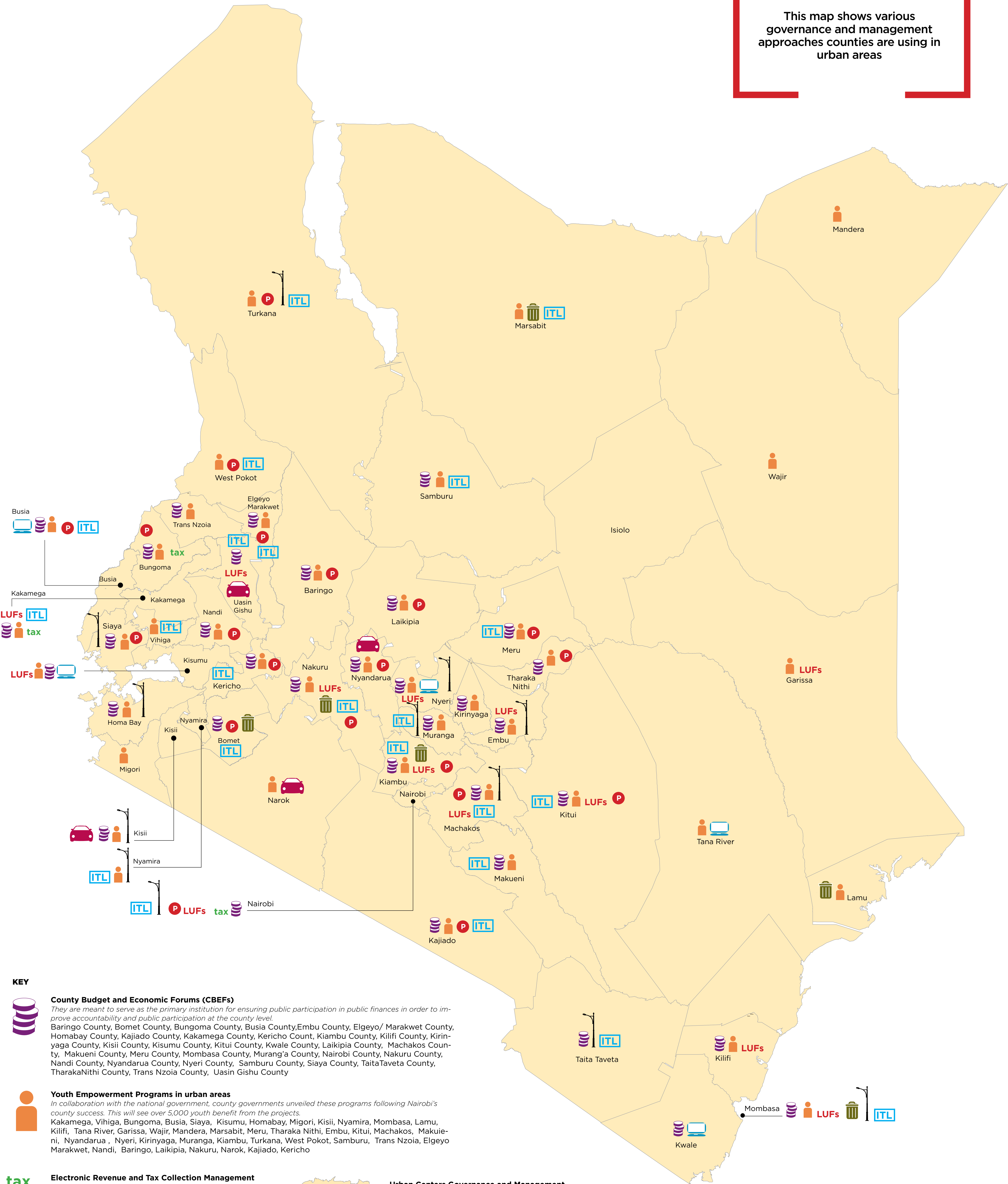

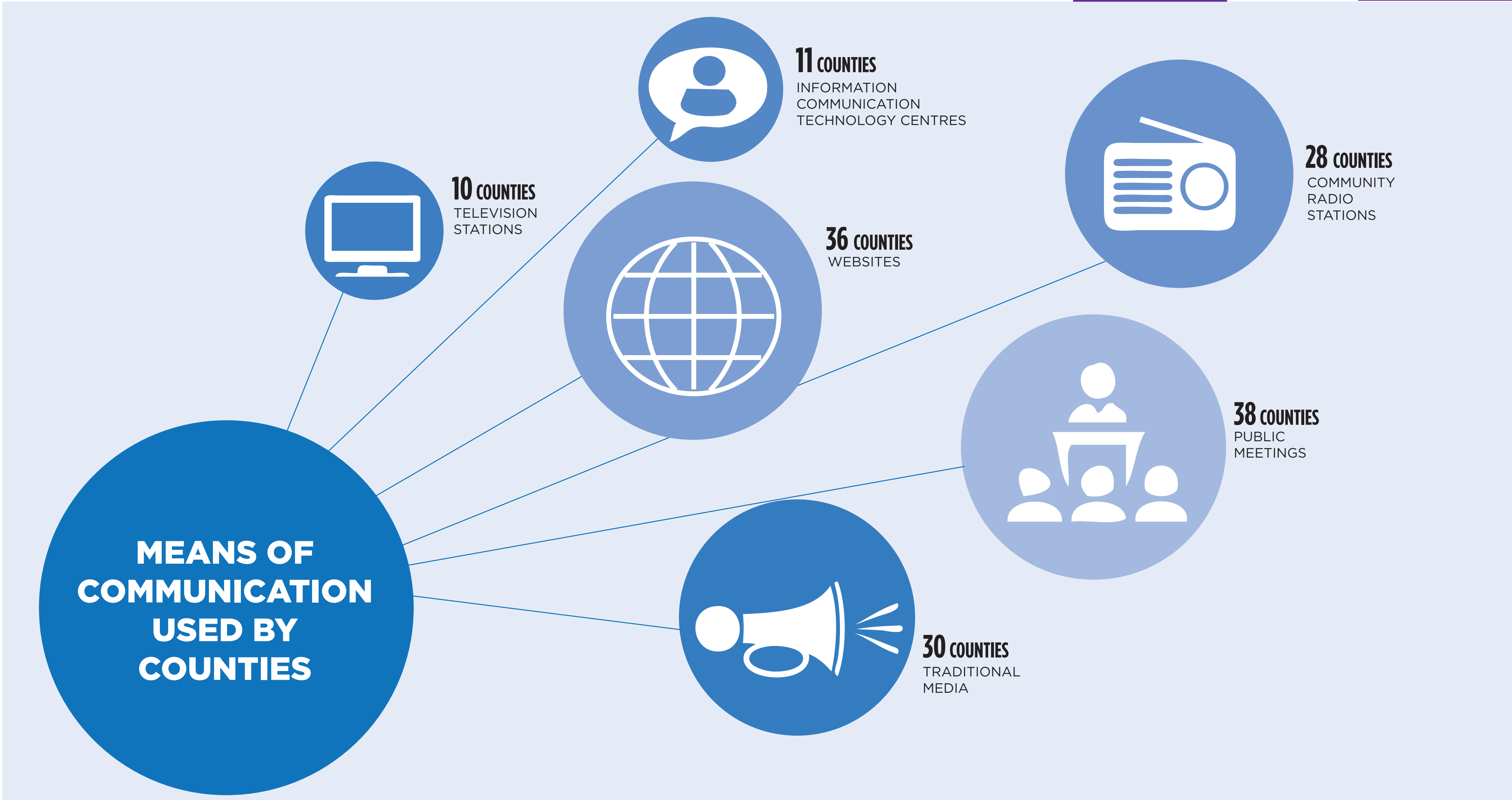
County Urban Governance Tools

This map shows various governance and management approaches counties are using in urban areas

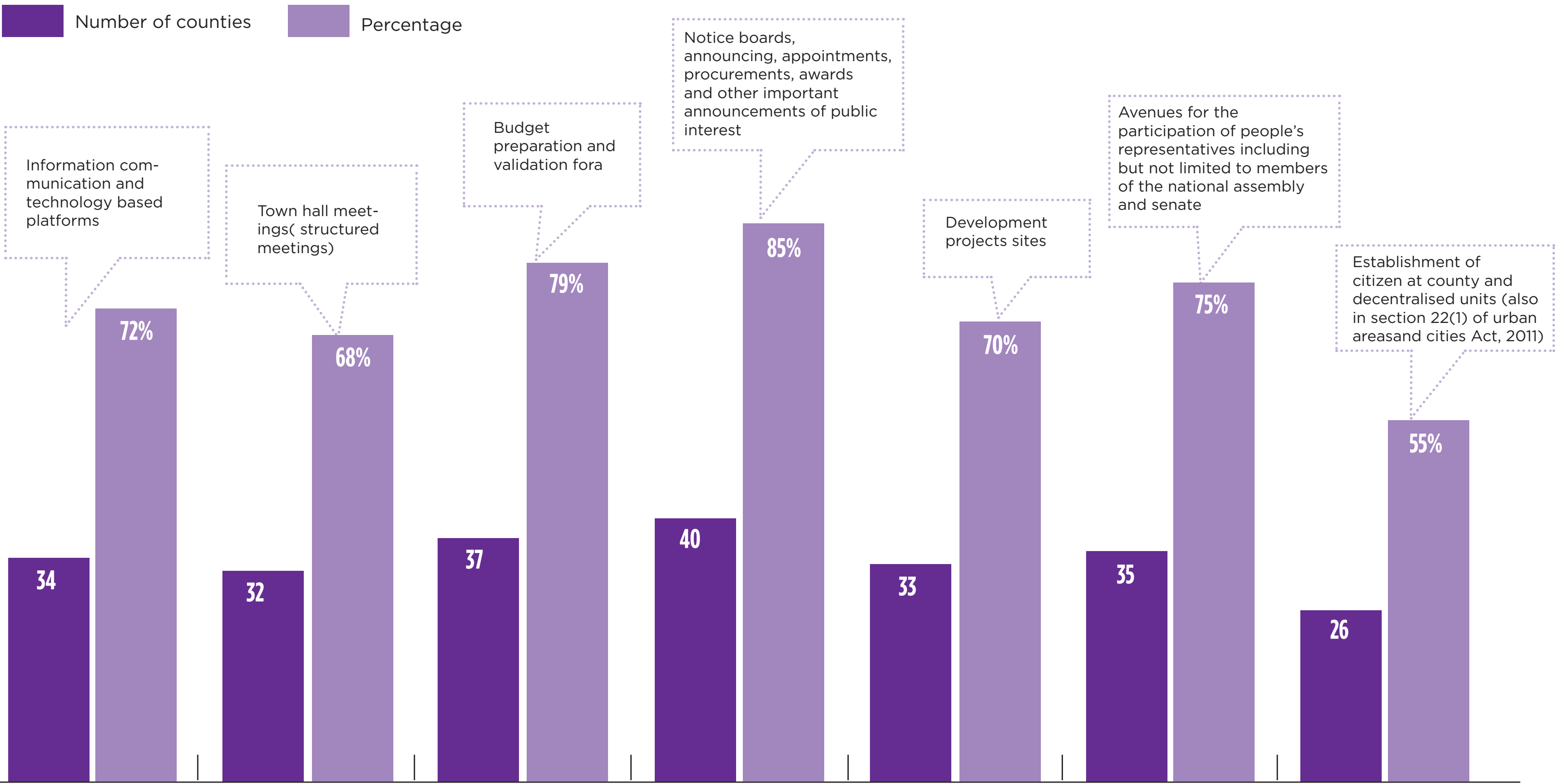

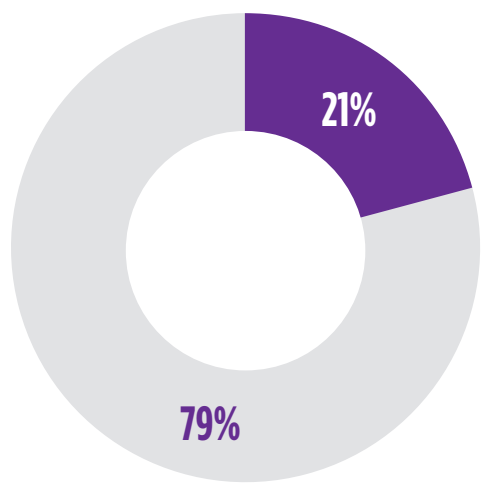

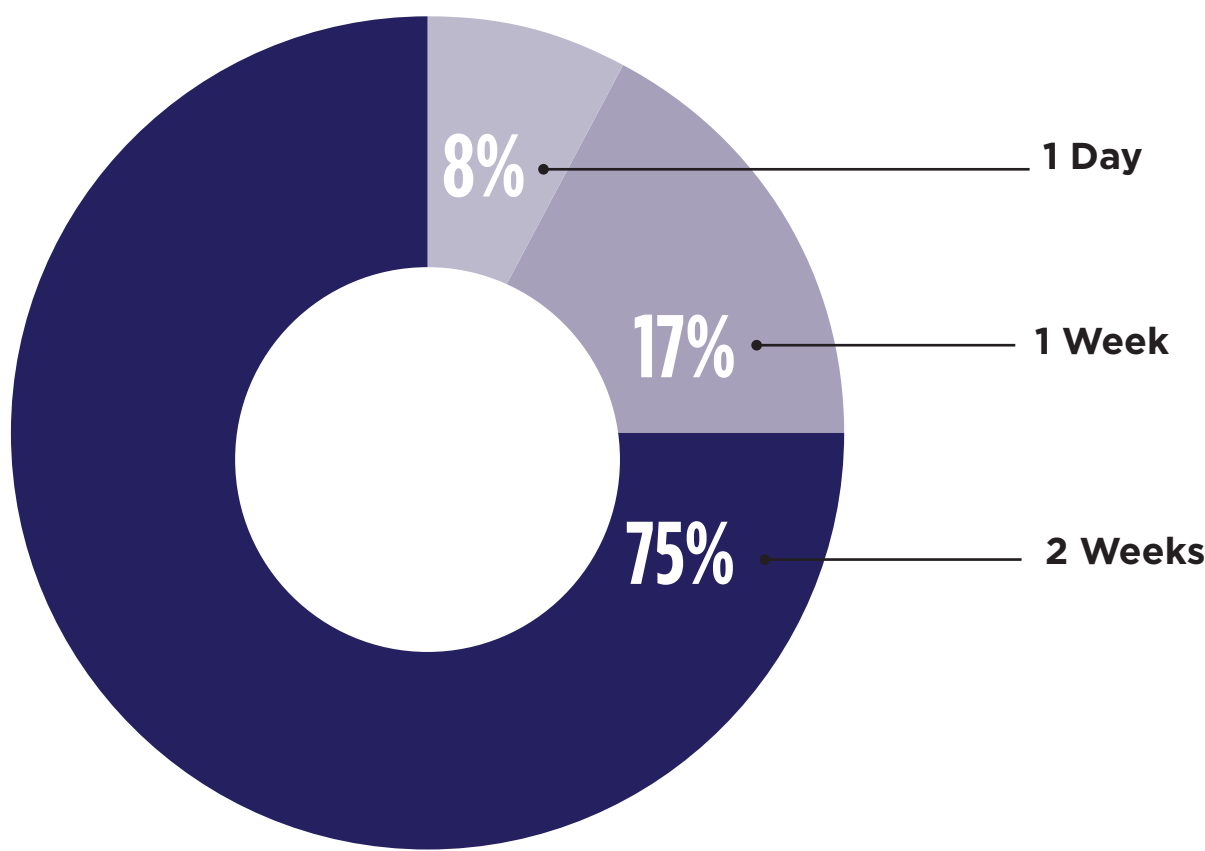
